## **Our Voluntary Homeowners Association**

If you are curious about why our neighborhood has an HOA, here is the history. When Woodmar Square was new, there was a conglomerate that wanted to build a high-rise office building at the location that is currently Swedish ER on Wadsworth. When the issue was before the Jefferson County Commissioners, residents were allowed to speak for 3 minutes each to explain their concerns about the construction. As an HOA, the JCC gave us 10 minutes to explain our concerns and with that came the weight of concern for our whole neighborhood, over that of a few residents. This was around 1975 and the building construction was turned down based partly on the concerns of our residents. Our HOA team did put together some covenants when the organization was created. Many of those covenants or rules have become Jefferson County Ordinances and Laws.

While our HOA was never created to put demands on our neighbors, we do have the weight of those Jeffco ordinances and rules that we all have to follow. Our website has the original covenants posted, as well as Jeffco rules posted at www.WoodmarSquare.org

Because we are a volunteer organization, we can make the HOA what we want! Our team is responsible for the front entrance property and for hosting and planning events that bring our neighbors together. We love that we live in a safe and social area and that everyone takes advantage of the parks and paths to wave and smile at each other.

## **National Wear Red Day**

National Wear Red Day, Friday February 7, is an annual campaign to raise awareness about heart disease in women. The national campaign urges women to learn their risk for heart disease and to take steps to lower their risk. What increases a woman's chances of heart disease? Smoking, sedentary lifestyle, family history, diabetes, stress, inflammatory diseases like rheumatoid arthritis and Crohn's complications during pregnancy menopause. We can prevent or reverse many of these risks by taking action. Speaking with our physician also helps to further lower our risk of heart attack and stroke by making and following a plan.

**Quit smoking/vaping.** Ask for help if you need it. Your physician has many tools at her side to make quitting a success.

**Change your lifestyle.** Become more active and improve your eating habits. This will help with many risk factors including stress, family history, and other health conditions.

**Get routine physical exams.** Heart disease and stroke kill one in three women. These diseases are 80 percent preventable according to Go Red for Women's official website.


